Accessible shower areas

Safety, accessibility and comfort are always in the forefront of our minds when designing and recommending accessible showers. For walk-in showers, wet-rooms or roll-in showers, we will only design the area with completely level floors as even the smallest lip can become a trip-hazard or an obstruction for wheelchair or commode users.




Underfloor heating is great for drying shower areas after use and provides greater warmth within the room.

Shower floor systems how does a level access shower floor work?

We are often asked how level access showers work, as there is no obvious shower tray installed! The flooring of a level access shower is generally a continuation of the rest of the floor in tile or vinyl, so there is nothing to step in or out of.

Beneath the floor surface sits a 22mm thick contoured deck that gives a gradient of 1:40 so water can run away to the floor drain. A membrane is then laid down on top, before the final tiles or vinyl flooring is laid, all of which guarantees the waterproof properties of the shower.



Shower floor grates

Depending on whether you choose a tiled or vinyl shower floor, the water will drain via a shower grate. All options are available in a variety of shapes and finishes.






- 3. Square shower grate


Shower screens

Level access walk-in showers can be enhanced with beautiful and flexible shower screens that offer different folding options to provide greater circulation space and user experience.









All bi-folding doors can fold outwards or inwards.

Bi-folding doors can be fixed in a number of configurations

such as a corner

enclosure.

Accessibility features

- Bi-folding screens are ideal where maximising circulation space is a necessity.
- A fixed screen with a pivoting panel can offer greater circulation space when entering the shower.
- Traditional shower curtains are weighted to avoid cling and feature in-built anti-bacterial properties.

Options and info

- Motionspot accessible shower screens and enclosures are made with toughened safety glass and floor seals to prevent water escape.
- Screens are available in widths of 600mm to 1200mm and are 2000mm high.
- Left and right-hand opening options.
- Made-to-measure screens can be manufactured on request.
- Self-cleaning properties within the glass provide the perfect solution to limescale build-up.

Screens are available as:

- **Single bi-fold**, folding back on itself or against a wall.
- Corner enclosure, typically on two sides from a wall to create a fully enclosed shower area.
- **In-line shower screen** which can enclose the shower area from opposite walls.
- Fixed shower screen with pivot panels can also act as a water deflector.
- **Split level shower screen** can be incredibly useful if carer washing is required.

Shower controls

Creating an accessible shower area that gives a luxury showering experience for all can be possible without compromising on style.

Accessibility features

- All Motionspot shower valves feature easy to operate lever handles avoiding any fiddly twist or turning actions.
- All come equipped with thermostatic controls or temperature limiters to avoid the potential for scalds.

Options and info


- Different shower valves are suitable for high and low pressure water systems.
- Exposed shower valves are easy to install as the body of the shower control sits exposed on the bathroom wall.
- Concealed shower valves are positioned flush with the shower wall with pipework hidden behind the wall.
- **Electric showers** offer a good solution when only a cold-water feed is available.
- **Digital showers** offer the ability to remotely activate the shower from a wall mounted button, phone or tablet and are ideal for ensuring the perfect water temperature before entering the shower.


Dependent on your chosen shower valve (and the number of outlets available), we would recommend:

- For exposed shower valves a **handheld shower head** on a riser rail.
- For concealed valves with dual outlets, an additional rainwater overhead shower head can be added as a feature in any accessible shower area.

Riser rails

Accessibility features

- For peace of mind whilst standing, transferring or moving within the shower area, each of our riser rails can support up to 150kg, avoiding the need for multiple grab rails within the shower area.
- The height of the shower head can be easily adjusted with one hand avoiding any fiddly adjustment.
- For additional support, the horizontal bar on the 'L' shaped rail can be ideally positioned to offer additional support around the bathroom.

- Either left or right-hand horizontal bars providing comfortable support within the shower area.

Shower seats

With a range of designs and finishes to suit all mobility requirements, Motionspot's wall mounted shower seats are stylish, comfortable and offer a range of postural support options.

With the ability to hinge against the wall, or be removed when not required, the seats are an excellent addition to an accessible shower room. All seats are supplied with specialist fixings to ensure safety and a secure fitting for up to 150kg of support.








Toilets

The importance of deciding the right height and projection for your toilet should not be underestimated. Dependent on the requirements of each client, Motionspot recommends an elevated toilet seat between 450-480mm in height from the floor. The projection of the toilet is also important for anyone transferring from a wheelchair or needing to use a commode chair. Increasing the height of the toilet can also help with anyone suffering from joint pain.











Wall hung and Back to wall toilets

Accessibility features

Wall hung

- Wall hung toilets can be mounted at the ideal height and are available in both long and short projection options.
- Good for transfer from a wheelchair or for use with a wheelchair commode.
- All wall hung and back to wall toilets can support up to 400kg.
- The toilets are easy to clean underneath and can create the illusion of greater space in the room.

Back to wall

- Back to wall toilets offer reassurance to anyone preferring the toilet to be fixed to the floor.
- Available in both long and short projection options.
- Standard (420mm) and comfort (450-480mm) heights available.

Options and info

- A range of traditional and modern styles including wash and dry versions are available
- Lighting can be added underneath the toilet to improve navigation to the toilet at night.

Flush plates

Flush plates are designed for wall hung and back to wall toilets where the flush is part of a concealed cistern. There are a variety of styles and options available that can suit everyone's access needs and individual style preferences.


Accessibility features

- Ease of use at the slightest touch. All Motionspot flushes are simple to use and contain either single or dual flush options.
- Sensor operated flush plates are perfect for anyone finding it difficult to reach or push a flush button.
- **Spatula levers** can be operated with an elbow from a seated position.
- Raised push buttons are positioned on the top of a cistern or concealed unit and can be easily operated with a clenched hand, or even an elbow.





Towel rails

The finishing touches in the bathroom are important and it's often the little things that make the biggest difference. If you've ever been frustrated by towels being positioned too far away from the walk-in shower, or toilet rolls being out of reach, Motionspot has a range of products which have been designed to make the most of your accessible bathroom.

Mirrors and storage

Combining storage options or for optimal light at the wash basin, there is a choice of mirrors to suit your bathroom style.

Accessibility features

- Fully lit mirrors improve visibility and help to avoid casting shadows whilst at the wash basin – an important factor for anyone with a sight impairment or dementia.
- Shaving mirrors are installed with extendable hinges. These mirrors can be pulled out towards anyone seated and provide better clarity for shaving or makeup application.

Basins

Many of the basins on the market have floor standing pedestals which can obstruct access to the basin from a seated position or a wheelchair. All Motionspot accessible basins are designed to be either wall hung with space underneath, inset (placed onto a counter top), or wall mounted with a semi-pedestal. Importantly, we ensure the bottle trap under the basin is fully insulated so there are no chances of burns from hot pipework.

We appreciate that storage is important in the bathroom and the natural place for a vanity unit is below the basin. We will consider the design of your space to offer alternative storage options that work for you.

- All Motionspot basins can be mounted at the ideal height for the user and are designed to ensure comfort when seated or standing.








Accessibility features

- All Motionspot taps are easy to operate by anyone struggling to twist or turn easily.
- Lever taps can be operated by a slight touch from a hand, fist, arm or elbow. This allows for the temperature to be easily controlled.
- Either temperature limiters or thermostatic mixing valves can be added to all of our taps to control the maximum temperature for anyone with sensitive skin or prone to burns.
- Sensor taps are easy to use with motion activation; the built-in limiter sets flow to run from approximately 10-30 seconds at a time.
- Wall mounted mixer taps allow for a clean minimal look, but can require additional plumbing to conceal pipework. They also require the user to be able to reach over the width of the basin.



- Chrome is still the most popular choice, but with a wide variety of styles and finishes available, the final style can be uniquely yours. Across the tap ranges, different finishes are available from chrome to brushed satin, antique gold, rose gold and black.





Safety and comfort

The finishing touches to any renovation can be the most exciting part of a bathroom project, however we are often asked about the potential dangers of falling in a bathroom or walk-in shower area. Safety and comfort is always at the forefront of our design rationale and all our slip resistant shower floors comply with HSE guidelines to prevent slips and trips in the bathroom.

Slip resistance

If the tiled look is preferred to vinyl flooring, Motionspot always specifies slip resistant tiles. Tile slip resistance is measured by the industry PTV (Pendulum Test Value) and offers the safest option for users. The minimum slip resistance value of 36+ is recommended in all commercial environments, but we would also recommend this within the home for safety.

Colour contrast

Thinking about the colour contrast between the floor and walls is also an important consideration when choosing your flooring and is important for anyone living with a sight impairment or dementia. Our team will advise on this when designing the right bathroom for you.
