

- Bi-folding glass shower doors. Increasing circulation space within rooms and providing a solution to the traditional accessible shower curtain.





Office Developments

Our approach to designing washroom accessibility within offices is applicable either at planning or redevelopment stage of any project. The development must be compliant for all users, with a recognition that staff or visitors with a disability may use the facilities.

Regulations stipulate that you can be no more that 40 metres from a wheelchair accessible toilet, an accessible shower room should be located in all offices and ambulant washrooms should be located on every floor.
