- Impacted regions include:
 - o the western coast of Denmark,
 - \circ the northern coast of Morocco,
 - o the southern part of England
 - \rightarrow Large number of displaced refugees, seeking refuge in Europe.
 - ightarrow No possibility of return due to extent of environmental damage
- Different refugee statuses:
 - Moroccans & Brittans: Eco Sanctuary Status Right to education, employment, healthcare & housing
 - Danes: EU-citizen all reserved rights for EU-citizens
- Affected (Fictive) EU Countries by refugee influx:
 - Aurelia
 - Silvantis
 - Veridia

Main challenges

 Labour market shortage
Demand for highly-skilled professionals Silvantis EU-country Language: Silvantian

Main challenges

- Strong but understaffed healthcare
- Attractive for refugees with health issues

Veridia EU-country Language: Veridian

Main challenges

- Imbalance of supply & demand on housing market
 - High rental costs
- Policy shift to collective housing for refugees
